## **LCHS ADOPTION CENTER VOLUNTEER ORIENTATION:**

Thank you so much for wanting to volunteer at the LCHS Adoption Center.

You will love it! The dogs and cats are all so sweet.

We walk the dogs every AM from 8:30-10:30 and every evening from 4:00-6 pm.

You are welcome any days to help... I have attached a map so you can see exactly where we are located. The following is an orientation to get you acquainted.

At The LCHS Adoption Center they rely on us, the volunteers, to give the dogs and cats attention, love and socialization as the staff works hard all day. Along with many other duties, they keep the center clean. They admit, feed and bathe the dogs and cats and administer medicine daily... We, the volunteers, make sure that the dogs and cats get love, socialization and get the exercise they need.

The more people that participate, the better walks for the dogs, and the more time they can be out on the trails... The cats always need cuddling too!

The staff can assist you at first with getting the dogs out of their pens, until you get used to it... Really easy and fun once you get to know them! Just wear clothes and shoes that can get dirty as the trails are all dirt... and bring water to drink because it's HOT!

Dogs on the top level go first. There are leashes hanging on the kennels. We walk the top level dogs out the front and to the left - there are trails that go way back and stay to the right. The dogs on the lower level are taken out the back gate and walked on the left side of the trails. Please ask the staff to instruct you to the correct paths.

There is a staff page on our website <http://www.loscaboshumanesociety.com> if you want to see who the staff is before you go... Evaristo is the Manger & Boss and speaks english. JOSUE is the staff manager and speaks English as well.

Also - We like to let people know: If you have dogs at home, or on vacation with you, be sure to wash well before touching them to prevent spreading germs to your own animals. Typically, if your dogs are vaccinated, with good immune systems they will be fine - just better to be safe and change clothes and shower after volunteering at the Adoption Center.
